As a Judge, I have tried all kinds of cases including jury trials of automobile accidents, medical malpractice, products liability, FELA, contracts, real estate, construction and others. I have been instrumental often as a mediator in effecting settlements of cases prior to trial and even during trial, some involving as much as several million dollars. I was a Circuit Judge in the City of St. Louis from January 1972 to December 31, 1992.

I practiced law for 21 years prior to being a Judge, including trial work, as well as other general practice matters. I practiced law from 1950 to 1972.

I have served as faculty adviser at the National Judicial College at the University of Nevada, Reno, Nevada.

ARBITRATION/MEDIATION TRAINING:

Attended a week-long, 26 hour, ADR seminar sponsored by the National Judicial College in 1991 (received training in arbitration, mediation, mini trials and summary jury trials). In May, 1993, received training from American Arbitration Association for the mediation of large, complex cases (6.6 hours). In March, 1994, received training from National Association of Security Dealers for the arbitration and mediation of security cases (4 hours). In April, 1995, received training from Academy of Attorney Mediators in the mediation of cases generally (8.1 hours). My total hours of ADR training is 44.7 hours. Since retiring from the bench on January 1, 1993, I have arbitrated or mediated over 300 cases. Approximately 240 mediations and over 60 arbitrations.

Currently, I also serve as a Senior Judge in the City of St. Louis on Division 1 matters when the presiding Judge is on vacation.
