ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

**WHEREAS**, on September 8, 2021 Hon. Mary Elizabeth Ott, Division 7, was elected Presiding Judge of the 21<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit, Saint Louis County, Missouri, and

**WHEREAS**, it is the practice of the 21<sup>st</sup> Circuit that the Presiding Judge not maintain a docket during the period of time in which the Presiding Judge remains in the office of Presiding Judge, and

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that the Governor of Missouri will appoint a Circuit Judge to fill the vacancy in Division 16 of the 21<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit, prior to December 31, 2021, and

**THEREFORE**, it is ordered that the cases assigned to Division 7, except those cases on the Probation Revocation Docket, and Criminal cases assigned a date for Trial, Plea or Scheduling Conference, and those civil cases reserved by Division 7, currently assigned to Division 7, are transferred to other civil-criminal dockets within this Circuit until such time as the docket is reassigned for future actions on the cases permanently.
