ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Presiding Judge to make judicial assignments and

WHEREAS, there is a current vacancy within a Division of the Circuit Court of Saint Louis County, and also an imminent, anticipated vacancy in a second Division of this Court, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Judiciary, and the public that, consistent with all statutory, and Court Operating Rule requirements, Judges change assignments from time to time, and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the Governor of the State of Missouri will appoint new Judges to those divisions that are currently or soon to be vacant, and

WHEREAS, most Divisions of this Court will maintain their current dockets, it will be necessary to transfer and change some dockets as follows, and

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that as of January 1, 2022 the following Divisions of the Circuit Court will be assigned the following Dockets:

Division 2 (Stewart) shall hear those cases previously assigned to Division 7 (Ott), and

Division 3 (Hemphill/Vacant) shall hear those cases previously assigned to Division 13 (Hilton),
and

Division 5 (Hardin-Tammons) shall hear those cases previously assigned to Division 2 (Stewart),
and

Division 7 (Ott) shall hear those cases on the Presiding Judge docket previously assigned to
Division 16 (Burton/Vacant), and

Division 10 (Dodson) shall be appointed Administrative Judge for the Family/Juvenile Court and shall hear those cases previously assigned to Division 3(Hemphill/Vacant), and

Division 13 (Hilton) shall hear those cases previously assigned to Division 19 (Albus), and

Division 16 (Vacant/Burton) shall hear those cases previously assigned to Division 5 (Hardin-Tammons), and also the Probation Revocation docket previously heard by Division 16 (Vacant/Burton), and

Division 19 (Albus) shall hear those cases previously assigned to Division 10 (Dodson), and

All other Divisions of the Circuit Court shall continue to hear the cases currently assigned to them, and

Except as set out herein, any Circuit Division currently hearing a Probation Revocation docket, shall continue to hear that same Probation Revocation docket as of January 1, 2022, and


