Whereas the Presiding Judge has the authority to assign dockets to individual Divisions of this Circuit, and


Whereas, it is in the best interest of the Judiciary and the Public that Traffic matters be handled expeditiously,

Therefore, it is the Order of this Court that beginning on January 1, 2022;

Those Traffic cases now assigned to Retired Judges Weisman and Goldman for administrative purposes only, shall be divided evenly and randomly assigned to Division 31, (Zellweger) Division 34, (McNelley) and Division 40, (Newsham), and these dockets shall be handled either by WebEx or in person at the discretion of the Judge in each Division, and

Those matters on the Associate Criminal docket concerning charges of Driving Under the Influence of Drugs and/or Alcohol will be divided evenly and randomly between Division 31, (Zellweger) Division 34, (McNelley) and Division 40, (Newsham), these dockets shall be handled in person. These cases shall be set for hearing as agreed by Division 31, (Zellweger) Division 34, (McNelley) and Division 40, (Newsham).
