ST. LOUIS COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, prior precedence of the Missouri Courts, and of the 21st Judicial Circuit requires the Presiding Judge to determine when the Courthouse shall close, including inter alia for the observance of holidays, *see, Heinen v. Healthline Management, Inc. (Mo.banc. December 22, 1998) 982 S.W.2d 244 1998 WL 887477, 80836,*


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Saint Louis County Courthouse shall be closed as follows;

Friday December 24, 2021 in observance of the Holiday Season, and shall close at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday December 23, 2021.

Friday December 31, 2021 in observance of the New Year Holiday, and shall close at 3:00 p.m. on Thursday December 30, 2021.

Essential Staff, such as Juvenile Detention Officers, are required to report as usual. The closure is also subject to the direction of individual Division Judges who may have matters scheduled on the dates of closure listed above. If you are required to remain in your Division on any of the dates listed above, I am advised by Joan Gilmer that you will receive "comp time". However, it is anticipated that most all employees will enjoy the benefit of the holidays.
