ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Honorable Thomas C. Albus is assigned to hear Circuit Civil and Circuit Criminal cases. The Circuit Clerk is ordered to prepare dockets for the Honorable Thomas C. Albus, as follows:

The Circuit Clerk is ordered to add the Honorable Thomas C. Albus into the random case assignment groups in order to randomly assign new Circuit Civil and new Circuit Criminal cases, effective immediately.

The Honorable Thomas C. Albus is assigned all active probation cases previously assigned to the Honorable Gloria Reno, effective immediately.

The pending criminal cases currently assigned to the Honorable Jason D. Dodson will be reassigned to the Honorable Thomas C. Albus. In addition, 15 criminal cases will be reassigned from the Honorable Stanley J. Wallach to the Honorable Thomas C. Albus and an additional 15 criminal cases will be reassigned from the Honorable John D. Warner, Jr. to the Honorable Thomas C. Albus. The reassignments are effective June 8, 2020

The Circuit Civil docket for the Honorable Thomas C. Albus will be created by reassigning pending circuit civil cases from those Circuit Judges having more than 475 pending circuit civil cases. The number of cases reassigned will vary by Judge, with the goal to equalize the Circuit Civil dockets. The Circuit Clerk is ordered to identify the specific cases to be reassigned to the Honorable Thomas C. Albus and a subsequent Administrative Order will be issued with an effective date of those reassignments.
