FAMILY COURT ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE ORDER NO. 184

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 40A AND
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 182 ON A TEMPORARY BASIS

WHEREAS, the Family Court of St. Louis County was created by Sections 487.010 through 487.190 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Sandra Farragut-Hemphill has been appointed Administrative Judge of the Family Court of St. Louis County pursuant to Section 487.010.3 RSMo.;

WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 40A (amended October 29, 2019) required parties to complete the parent education program in person with certain exceptions.

WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 182 allowed the completion of the parent education program through the on-line program, "Focus on Kids," on a temporary basis;

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the completion of the parent education program may be completed through either of the following on-line programs: "Focus on Kids" or "St. Louis County Parent Education Program" sponsored by Parent Educators, LLC. Both of the forgoing programs shall satisfy the requirements of Administrative Order 40A (amended October 29, 2019) on a temporary basis.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Circuit Clerk provide notice of this Administrative Order by causing this order to be published as soon as practicable in *The St. Louis Countian*, by posting a copy of this order in a conspicuous place in the Office of the Circuit Clerk, and by making copies of this order available for distribution from the Office of the Circuit Clerk.
